Monthly Care Calendar

Spring (March-May)

March

- Remove winter protection
- Clean containers and check drainage
- Prune dead/damaged growth
- Apply first fertilizer of season

April

- Monitor new growth
- Begin regular watering schedule
- Start hardening off indoor plants
- Check for pest issues

May

- Begin regular harvesting
- Increase watering frequency
- Start outdoor container placement
- Monitor for flower buds

Summer (June-August)

• June

- Maintain regular harvesting
- Check moisture levels daily
- Apply second round of fertilizer
- Pinch back growing tips

July

- Provide afternoon shade if needed
- Monitor for pest issues
- Continue regular harvesting
- Check container drainage

August

- Continue harvesting
- Watch for flower buds
- Check for root binding
- Apply final summer fertilizer

Fall (September-November)

September

- Begin reducing watering
- Take cuttings for indoor growing
- · Final harvest for drying/freezing
- Clean up dead foliage

October

- Prepare for indoor moving
- Reduce fertilization
- Check for pests before moving
- Clean containers

November

- Move containers indoors/protected area
- Reduce watering frequency
- Final cleanup of dead growth
- Check indoor lighting setup

Winter (December-February)

December

- Maintain minimal watering
- Monitor indoor humidity
- Check for pest issues
- Light pruning if needed

January

- Continue minimal watering
- Plan spring container changes
- Monitor indoor temperature
- Check plant health

February

- Begin increasing water slightly
- Prepare spring supplies
- Check grows lights
- Plan propagation schedule

Essential Maintenance Checklist

Daily Tasks

- Check soil moisture
- Monitor for pest activity
- Ensure adequate ventilation
- Check light conditions

Weekly Tasks

- Rotate containers for even growth
- Harvest as needed
- Remove any yellow/dead leaves
- Check for new growth issues
- Monitor drainage function

Monthly Tasks

- Apply organic fertilizer (growing season)
- Clean container exterior
- Check for root growth through drainage
- Prune for shape maintenance
- Monitor container condition

Seasonal Tasks

- Clean and sanitize containers
- Replace or refresh potting mix
- Division of overcrowded plants
- Check structural integrity of containers
- Update plant markers/labels

Harvest & Storage Prep

- Clean pruning tools
- Prepare drying area
- Clean storage containers
- Label preserved herbs
- Check storage conditions

Emergency Care Checklist

Monitor for these issues:

- Yellowing leaves
- Wilting despite moisture
- Pest infestations
- Root rot symptoms
- Leggy growth
- Leaf spots/disease

Supply Inventory Checklist

- Potting soil
- Organic fertilizer
- Container drain trays
- Pruning tools
- Plant markers
- Pest control supplies
- Storage containers

Record Keeping

Track:

- Planting dates
- Fertilizer applications
- Pest treatments
- Harvest amounts
- Container rotations
- Propagation success
- Growth issues
